



BEAUTIFUL PERTH AWARDS GUIDANCE FOR THE BEAUTIFUL PERTH ENVIRONMENT AWARD

This award celebrates the work done by residents, businesses, community groups and schools in Perth who are helping improve not only our local environment, but also the global environment. It is being managed in conjunction with Zero Waste Perth, which is donating a trophy for the award.

Eligible entries

All entrants to other categories of Beautiful Perth Award may also enter for the Environment Award.

How the Awards work

Beautiful Perth Awards are designed to celebrate your achievements, whatever the scale of your entry. We use the Royal Horticultural Society's system of awarding Bronze, Silver, Silver Gilt and Gold levels, so entries in all stages of development can receive an Award, and you can enter whether you are a beginner or an expert!

Judging criteria

Beautiful Perth judges will visit in early August to assess entries using four criteria:

- the best upcycled, recycled or reused garden feature
- resource management (eg water use, reuse of 'waste' materials etc)
- wildlife friendly features (eg pollinator plats, bug hotels etc)
- overall presentation and maintenance

Other Categories

Entrants for this award may also enter for the Residential, Business or Community awards categories, and/or for these new awards:

Vegetable Gardening: The judges will be looking for the most productive and best kept vegetable growing in an individual allotment, garden, plot, raised beds or other containers.

Best Solheim Cup Display. To celebrate the Solheim Cup being held in Perthshire in 2019, the winner of this award will receive a trophy donated by the IMG Sports Management Company and £50. There will also be certificates for each entry. The



judges will look for relevance to the Solheim Cup (25 points), visual impact (50 points) and horticultural practice (25 points).
